As per the ATP Rulebook, TIES shall be resolved as follows:

1. Team using two (2) singles rankings.

2. Team using one (1) singles ranking.

3. A team using a protected ranking is positioned below the other team.

4. If teams have the same composition, priority is given to the team with the strongest individual singles ranking. For teams using 2 doubles rankings, the fewest number of tournaments played then team with highest number of points.
